## DAY 2

(Mon) March 23, 2026: LIMA PERUVIAN GASTRONOMIC

Embark on a full-day culinary exploration of Lima, the gastronomic capital of South America, with the passionate chef. Your journey begins with a guided visit to a traditional local market, where you'll discover the incredible variety of fruits, herbs, and ingredients native to Peru's Coast, Highlands, and Amazon regions. Led by a culinary expert, you'll gain a deeper understanding of how these elements are used in both traditional and modern Peruvian cuisine.

Next, we'll stroll through the bohemian district of Barranco, Lima's vibrant artistic heart. Its colourful streets restored Republican-era mansions, contemporary art galleries, and bold murals reflect the city's creative soul and sophisticated charm.

Later, you will take part in an interactive cooking class designed to introduce you to the richness of Peruvian gastronomy, one of the most diverse and celebrated cuisines in the world. In a relaxed and social environment, you will learn to prepare traditional Peruvian dishes, guided by local chefs.

The experience begins with a Pisco Master Class, where you'll discover the origins and varieties of Peru's national spirit and learn how to prepare a classic chilcano de pisco. Throughout the session, you'll also enjoy a tasting of Peruvian fruits, receive a recipe book in English, and take home a personalized apron and a culinary souvenir such as Maras salt, premium chocolates, or specialty coffee. At the end of the class, you'll enjoy the dishes you've created.





For the rest of the afternoon, you will view the colonial site of Lima, where you can appreciate the exquisite architecture. Then, stroll over to the Cathedral. The Church and Convent of Santo Domingo date back to the late 16th century. The monastery is one of the best-preserved ones in Lima.

Before concluding the tour, you will enjoy a special moment at an exclusive rooftop located in one of the city's most emblematic historic venues.

Your journey begins in Iquitos, where the team welcomes you at the airport and transfers you to Nauta in a private vehicle. Along the way, enjoy a light lunch box.

At the port of Nauta, you will board the Delfin III and settle into your suite.

You will attend an introductory briefing with your naturalist guide: geography, biodiversity, and local culture.

At sunset, you'll head out on a skiff to explore the flooded forest. You'll get close to the treetops, where you can observe birds and monkeys. At night, you'll search for caimans, owls, and other nocturnal animals under a starry sky.

# DAY 4

(Wed) March 25, 2026: IQUITOS

In the morning, you will explore the Amazon Natural Park, a sanctuary of lush vegetation and biodiversity. As you walk along its trails, you will learn about the medicinal plants and ancestral knowledge that sustain local communities and form an essential part of Amazonian culture. Later, you will participate in a traditional ceremony with a local shaman, an ancient ritual of connection and gratitude to nature, offering a deeper understanding of the spiritual relationship between the Amazon and its people.

In the afternoon, you will navigate the Yanayacu Pucate River by kayak, one of the most pristine waterways in the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve. Surrounded by the sounds of the rainforest and mirror-like reflections of the trees on the water, this experience allows you to observe pink dolphins, tropical birds, and the extraordinary biodiversity that defines the Peruvian Amazon.

# DAY 5

(Thu) March 26, 2026: IQUITOS

In the morning, you will take a guided walk through the rainforest at Fundo Casual, a pristine area that showcases the Amazon's remarkable biodiversity. Along the trail, you will observe towering ceiba trees, lush tropical vegetation, and a wide variety of birds and insects. Your naturalist guide will explain the ecological importance of this ecosystem and how local communities use plants for food, medicine, and daily life.

In the afternoon, you will experience piranha fishing, a traditional Amazonian practice that reflects the deep connection between the river and its people. As evening falls, you will return to Nauta Caño for a night safari — an unforgettable journey through the darkened waterways where you may spot caimans, owls, and other nocturnal creatures that bring the jungle to life under the stars.

# DAY 6

(Fri) March 27, 2026: IQUITOS

Before breakfast, you will witness the confluence of the rivers, "Unión de los Ríos" you will distinguish colors of the 3 rivers. It is known that the Ucayali River, which in turn confluences with the Marañon River upstream of Iquitos, Peru, to form what countries other than Brazil consider to be the main stem of the Amazon River. In the morning, you will visit the community of San José de Parapapura, where you will learn about the customs, daily life, and craftsmanship of the local people. Their traditions, passed down through generations, reveal the harmony between culture and the river's rhythm.

In the afternoon, you will explore the Yarapa River by skiff. As you glide through its calm waters, you will encounter a rich diversity of wildlife — hawks, terns, herons, and playful monkeys such as the pygmy marmoset, squirrel monkey, and monk saki. Along the way, you'll also meet the ribereños, Amazonian river dwellers whose lives are deeply connected to the water and the forest that surrounds them.

# DAY 7

(Sat) March 28, 2026: IQUITOS

After breakfast, you will disembark in Nauta and travel by private vehicle back to Iquitos. On the way, you will stop at an interpretation center dedicated to Melipona bees, a stingless species vital for the rainforest's pollination and ecological balance. These native bees play a crucial role in sustaining biodiversity and have long been valued by Amazonian communities for their medicinal honey.

Your journey continues to the Ornamental Fish Research Center, where you will observe some of the most fascinating aquatic species of the Amazon, including the arapaima, one of the largest freshwater fish in the world, and elegant freshwater stingrays.

At the end of your visit, the team will assist you with your luggage and check-in at the Iquitos airport to take your flight to Lima for your international connection.

### **Recommendations:**

- Itineraries are subject to change due to weather or river conditions, at the discretion of the crew.
- Expect a warm and humid climate, with temperatures ranging between 21°C and 33°C (70°F to 90°F).
- It is recommended to take Vitamin B or B-15 before travel, in addition to using insect repellent and anti-itch creams.



- Community visits: It is possible to create very intimate experiences with the local native community people. For example, there are many young children and families in communities who have various needs in the absence of their own resources, so any help will be very useful. Kids love shirts (T-shirts), pencils, notebooks, and toys. Candies to distribute among them are also great sources of joy
- Larger suitcases are stored in Nauta.
