Arrive in Puerto Maldonado, the capital of Madre de Dios, and join a 1-hour bus and a 2.5-boat journey to the lodge. Your first taste of the Amazon cuisine will be in the river while you leave the city to enjoy the fantastic jungle landscapes.

As we cross the confluence with the Malinowski River, we will leave behind the final traces of human habitation. Within the 700,000 hectares of an uninhabited nucleus of the Tambopata National Reserve, sightings of capybara, caiman, geese, macaws, and other large species will become more frequent.

The Tambopata Research Center, a unique and spacious boutique ecolodge, is your destination. Complete with a bar, a massage centre, and buffet service, it's nestled in the heart of the National Reserve of Tambopata. As the only lodge inside the reserve, it offers a truly exclusive experience, with various macaw nests belonging to the Macaw Project just a stone's throw away.

Accommodation includes rooms from 21 mts to 83 mts suites with a private bathroom and an open window facing the forest.



Your stay at the Tambopata Research Center is all-inclusive. Enjoy three meals daily, guided excursions and activities, refreshments upon arrival, and airport transfers. We even assign guides on private small groups of 6:1, ensuring a personalized and hassle-free experience.

This afternoon, we join the Overlook. A three—to five-kilometer hike will lead us to overlooks that command magnificent views of the Tambopata winding its way into the lowlands. The forest on this trail, regenerating the old bamboo forest, is suitable for Howler Monkey and Dusky Titi Monkey. You can hike out at night when most mammals are active but difficult to see. Frogs with shapes and sounds as bizarre as their natural histories are easier to find.

Important note:

At the time of registration, the reception area will inform you about the activities that it has included to choose from according to your interest and/or motivation. We will detail these à la carte activities below:

- **Red Macaw Sighting:** On clear mornings of the year, dozens of large macaws and hundreds of parrots and parakeets congregate in a raucous and colorful spectacle on a cliff near the lodge.
- **Bird Watching Beginners - Moderate - Expert:** Learn how to become an enthusiastic bird watcher. The world of birds is diverse and the ideal place to enjoy bird watching.
- **Secrets of the Surrounding Area:** Explore the surrounding gardens at a relaxed pace. A forest surrounds the lodge, so it is not necessary to go far to have exciting encounters with the great diversity of flora and fauna.
- **Search for the monkeys:** This 5 km trail covers a completely different habitat with smaller and thinner trees on the top of the hills and slopes. Great opportunity to learn about these curious and lively inhabitants of the jungle.



- **Exploring the Island and the water hole:** 10 minutes upriver from the lodge, we find a small lagoon with a platform in the middle. You will have the opportunity to learn about the varieties of fish that live in the Amazon.

- **Hike to the aguajal:** The aguaje palms are one of the most important food sources in the jungle. Unfortunately, humans are predating this habitat since these spaces are used to plant rice. Swamps are truly picturesque habitats.

- **The world of butterflies:** If you love butterflies, you will enjoy this activity. This is a delightful viewing experience, and you will have the opportunity to photograph these colorful creatures.

- **Walk to La Ceiba:** Today, you will take a walk to La Ceiba. The highlight of this walk is the encounter with the largest tree in the surroundings: a giant ceiba. During the walk, we will focus on the natural history of this majestic tree and learn why they are so special.

- **Adventure in the Bowl:** This is a 4-hour hike through various habitats. This is an early morning activity and one of the most rewarding in terms of wildlife encounters.

- **Bamboo Path:** Bamboo is a fast-growing plant. Learn more about which species choose this ecosystem as their home. This trail is particularly attractive for bird lovers.

- **Master Hike:** This is the perfect excursion for the hardcore hiker and nature lover. Crossing through a variety of ecosystems and an endless network of trails, this hike will last around 6 hours and will maximize your opportunities for wildlife.

- **Night Walk:** Most of the jungle comes to life at night.



Suggested Activity:

- Walk to the Viewpoint

A walk of three to five kilometers will take us first to visit the viewpoints, and then we will enjoy the magnificent views of Tambopata that make their way into the lowlands. This forest regenerates from the old bamboo forest, which is used by the howler monkey and the dark titi monkey.

You will have the option to hike at night when most mammals are active but difficult to see. Frogs are easy to find with shapes and sound as strange as their natural stories.

DAY 2

TAMBOPATA RESEARCH CENTER

On most clear mornings of the year, dozens of large macaws and hundreds of parrots congregate on this large river bank in a raucous and colourful spectacle that inspired a National Geographic cover story. Discretely located fifty meters from the cliff, we will observe green-winged, scarlet, blue-and-gold macaws and several species of smaller parrots that descend to ingest clay. Outings are at dawn when the lick is most active.

This five-kilometre trail covers the prototypical rainforest with immense trees crisscrossed by creeks and ponds. Amongst the figs, ceibas, and chihuahuas, we will go for a monkey search: Squirrel, Brown Capuchin, and Spider Monkeys, as well as peccaries. TRC is located within this habitat.

Ten minutes upriver from the lodge, explore the island, which has a tiny pond with a platform in the middle. It is a great place to spot waterfowl such as the Muscovy duck, sunbittern, and hoatzin, as well as woodpeckers, oropendolas, flycatchers, and parakeets that call this pond home.



After dinner, scientists will provide night lectures, an in-depth look at macaw biology, feeding habits, theories for clay lick use, breeding and feeding ecology, population fluctuations, and threats to their conservation.

DAY 3

TAMBOPATA RESEARCH CENTER

Step carefully over the winding 'highways' of peaceful leaf-cutter ants on the Rainforest Master Hike. This five-kilometer trail covers the prototypical rainforest with immense trees crisscrossed by creeks and ponds. Our experienced guides will point out the tiniest bird hiding in the canopy, the most elusive monkey, and the most spectacular plant life, leaving you with unforgettable memories and a profound sense of accomplishment.

Twilight descends early in the jungle. Under the thick tree cover of the rainforest, darkness falls quickly when the light can no longer slip through the foliage. As afternoon slips into evening, you'll witness one of the world's most spectacular sunsets. The Sunset Cruise floats down the broad river, countless oranges and pinks reflecting off the water in lovely patterns, a breathtaking display of nature's beauty that will leave you awe-inspired.


